- The Accelerated Baccalaureate to master's degree program has now been approved to allow up to 15 graduate level credit hours to apply toward the graduate degree. This was approved at the December Graduate Council Meeting to accommodate a request from the Emerging Scholars Program (YEL).

We have 14 applicants for spring and 9 for Summer/Fall.

The **SEC ALDP Alumni Fellows** who have graduated from the program within the past five years are eligible to apply for the Alumni Fellowships to support visits to administrative units at other SEC schools. Two fellowships are awarded each year. This call will go out early next semester and the recipients of the fellowships are announced in July.

- UCAA is also working on an Academic Advisors Training Module and will host a workshop for new advisors in the spring. More information will be forthcoming.
