1. Consideration of the minutes

Upon a motion made by Dr. Robert Green and seconded by Dr. Ian Munn, the minutes from March 10, 2021 were approved with no edits.

2. Announcements:

- Effective January 2022 the criteria for admitting students to a program under the Academic Common Market are as follows:
 - A composite ACT score of 22
 - The requirement of a sub score of 19 for Math and English remain the same.
 - The high school core requirement is changed from a 2.5 to a 2.75 GPA.
 - Any college transfer credit is changed from a 2.5 to a 2.75 GPA and all MSU earned credits must be a 2.75 GPA or better.
- Students currently enrolled under the Academic Common Market Program will not be impacted by these new criteria. However, if a student has to reapply for access to their degree program through the ACM, they will be readmitted under the new criteria.
- Dr. Dickerson stated that Commencement Ceremonies will be held on April 29 and 30. Tickets will be required, and each graduate will have 4 tickets for their guests. Face coverings will be required. Faculty should notify the Registrar's Office if they plan to attend so adequate seating can be arranged.

Doctoral medallions have been ordered and will be presented to Doctoral graduate students. These will likely be given to the students by the colleges during the hooding ceremonies.

• Fall Convocation will be held in-person on August 24, 2021.
