1. Consideration of the minutes

Upon a motion made by Dr. Robert Green and a second by Dr. Kevin Rogers, the minutes from March 8, 2023, were approved.

- 2. New Math Pathways Dr. Rick Travis & Dr. Kim Walters
 - Dr. Travis initiated and participated in a Math Summit at Mississippi State University (MSU) on March 21, 2023, to review proposed changes to the General Education Math requirements. It was a successful and positive meeting. Some of the topics discussed at the summit are listed below.
 - Retroactive application of the proposed new three credit hour Math rule who benefits?
 - Quantitative Reasoning as an alternative pathway to meeting the three-credit hour Math rule. The Office of Institutional Research and Effectiveness will compile a list of students who might benefit form alternate math pathways.
- 3. First Destination Survey Results and Successful Career Outcomes Ms. Bethany Mills & Mr. Ed Dechert
 - Ms. Mills and Mr. Dechert shared information with council members regarding the 2021-2022 First Destination Survey Summary Report. The survey is administered to all MSU graduates upon graduation, and data is collected for a period of six months to determine the employment/continuing education status of recently graduated students.
 - The knowledge rate (percentage of graduates for which reliable outcome data has been collected) for all MSU graduates is 77%, and of the 77% of graduates for which data is available, 94% reported a successful career outcome within six months of graduation.
 - Mr. Dechert shared the survey results with the council during the meeting and a hard copy will be emailed to them as well.
